

## A.C. Frieden Heads to Brazil and Uruguay for Literary Research

**CHUI, Brazil (Jan. 3, 2010)** – Chicago-based author-lawyer A.C. Frieden spent nearly two weeks in Uruguay and southern Brazil, in part to gather information for an upcoming novel and an aerial photography book. "Uruguay is not only a great destination for relaxation and fun, it also has some fascinating features that tie in well with a political thriller I am currently writing," said Frieden.

Frieden began his trip in Montevideo, Uruguay's capital, and then headed to the posh resort town of Punta del Este. He also visited Punta del Diablo and La Paloma, two bohemian seaside towns northeast of Punta del Este. Frieden continued his journey along the Uruguay coast to Brazil's southernmost town, Chuí. At each of the locations Frieden took in as much information as possible for his literary projects. "I enjoy off-the-beaten-path places," Frieden said of his research travel, "because they are often more interesting than well known venues."

In Punta del Este, Frieden flew a Cessna 172 along the coast taking in the amazing scenery. "This is my third trip here but my first flying in the area," said Frieden.
