Author A.C. Frieden Visits Ukraine's National Aviation Museum

KIEV, Ukraine (May 17, 2013) – Author A.C. Frieden visited the Ukrainian National Aviation Museum in Kiev. The museum hosts one of the largest collections of Soviet-designed combat and transport aircraft outside Russia. "For any spy novelist writing, this museum is a must-see," said Frieden. Opened in 2003, the museum is located next to Zhulyany Airport, one of two civilian airports serving Ukraine's capital, and shares its space with the adjacent National Aviation University.

"Of special interest to me," said Frieden, "is the museum's collection of strategic bombers, including three versions of the Tupolev Tu-22 *Backfire* bomber and the Tu-95 *Bear.*" Very few museums in the world have access to these large aircraft, some of which are still operating. The museum also features aircraft from other Soviet and Russian design bureaus, including Yakovlev, Ilyushin, Antonov, Sukhoi, Mikoyan-Gurevich (MiG), Kamov, Mil, and Beriev. The collection includes experimental, prototype, and production versions of fixed wing aircraft, floatplanes and helicopters.
